Objective

- The general objective of this project is to add in quality of education at “Special ability schools” where the indigenous students are the principal actors in the transformation of their education system.
- **“Little Champ”** itself clears objective of program which target the hidden talent of a student. Our goal is to make every child a “Little champion” in his/her life.

Justification of our initiative

- This project is considered best practice for both its **innovative methodology** and **sustainability**.
- The methodology allowed students to be the **primary actors** in the transformation of their own education system, **building ownership** and commitment to the program on behalf of the communities they serve.
- At the same time, articulating this **state of art program** with “Special ability Schools” our education training system **ensured sustainability**.
- We have to work with students who are under poverty and not enjoying the **essence of life** which is lacking in current system.
- Current system is not allowing students to make aware about “Out of world’ life which exist within the city.
- We are here to **boost** student’s **confidence** and to realize them they are not different from other kids.

Journey to Himalaya program is for school and college students who want to get an exposure about trekking at mountain and want to enjoy another culture, food and education system. This program is to develop self confidence, show case our traditional Gujarati culture and to become open minded to accept another culture.

Why program is for Special Ability students

- Students are coming from very low income background who never visited out of town.
- Special ability students find competition among selves to study hard to enroll for this project.
- School can't organize such programs out of state for students, it's expensive.
- Students will learn, show talent and make friends out of town which give them an exposure which is very essential for each student in life.
- Participants will share their experience among students which motivates them for overall development.
- Students will find opportunities to interact with other people which make difference to see the special ability people among society.
- Many students are living in Slums and roadside Kaccha makan, their parents are working in housekeeping job in other houses where they interact with other students who have this kind of programs in their private schools. Underprivileged students also have dreams to get an exposure which Vishvet Foundation wants to give them.
- We are also working together with policies and initiatives taken by Gujarat Government for students so that benefits of each policy will reach to every student.

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Why we do this?

- Students who have dream to go different places but financially not capable will be a part of this program.
- Students who has good academic score in class and active in school activities only allowed to take part in this program.
- We want to give students a motivation to study hard, take part in extracurricular and get chance to visit out of Gujarat.

Selection Procedure

Criteria of Selection

Above 12 years age, Self discipline, highest attendance, study record and grades in class, active in extracurricular activities, behavior in school and with classmates, Parent's written approval, personal interview of 30 students out of 20 students need to select.

We take help of school principal and teacher.

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Program Itinerary – (It runs around the year)

Day	Activity
Day 1 Depart from Ahmedabad	Departure from Ahmedabad Railway Station – Second class Sleeper up to Delhi.
Day 2	Reached at Delhi Railway station. Take Bus from Delhi to Manali at night.
Day 3 Visit around Manali	Received by local team and transfer to campsite. After breakfast trek to old Manali, Hadimba temple, shiva temple and evening explore the town. Visit to local school at Manali town and interact with students. Some Cultural exchange programs . Overnight at camp
Day 4 Rock climbing and rappelling	Natural or Free climbing and Artificial climbing Rappelling : When the rock face is difficult to climb down due to steepness , wetness or some other reason , rappelling is the best way to climb down . rappelling or abseiling or roping down as it is most commonly called , is a quick method of descending over a steep face of rock , snow or ice by sliding down a fix single or double rope anchored on top. After Lunch River crossing (Tyrolean traverse technique) While trekking in mountain , one have to cross several stream , To cross these streams one should have good knowledge that how to cross the mountain stream ? Crossing these streams / rivers with technique and full safety called river crossing. Evening Burma bridge activities for increasing self confidence and become brave. After dinner camp fire.
Day 5 Trek to Jogni fall and Vashisht. (Pack lunch)	Day hike of Jogni Fall through some Villages and green fields and Pine forests spend some time at Jogni Fall and later walk down till to vashisht village. This is famous for hot water sulphar and visit vashist temple of saint (vashist rishi) and lord Rama, one can have dip in hot sulphar water which is recommended for skin diseases, after walk back through Bahang via Goshal village to camp site. Overnight at camp.
Day 6 Trek to Top camp (Moridugah- 2800mtr.) (5hrs)	After an early breakfast you leave for Top Camp (Moridugah). The trek gives a panoramic view of Manali valley. All the famous peaks of Kullu Himalaya--- Indrasan, DeoTibba, Hanuman Tibba, Makerbeh, Shikarbeh, Shitidhar, Friendship Peak, Khand Pari and Ladakhi put on show themselves around you. An excellent trek for photography. Night in camp (Jungle Camp)
Day 7 Bhrigu Lake Trek (4300M) 6/7hrs walk	After an early breakfast you leave for Bhrigu Lake. The trek gives a panoramic view of Manali valley. All the famous peaks of Kullu Himalaya--- Indrasan, DeoTibba, Hanuman Tibba, Makerbeh, Shikarbeh, Shitidhar, Friendship Peak, KhandPari and Ladakhi put on show themselves around you. An excellent trek for photography. After reaching at Bhrigu spending some time there you descend down to the Jungle Camp.
Day 8	After breakfast walk to snow point for snow activities, Lunch at camp and back Journey for Manali. Descend down to village Vashisht down in the valley. Night

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Trek to snow line (1hrs) and Vashisht (3hrs)	in camp.
Day 9	Say Good Bye to all other campers, management, Guides and cooks.
Depart from Manali	After lunch departure to bus stand.
Day 10	Reach at Delhi Visit to capital of India. (Depends on Train time schedule)
Day 11	Arrival at Ahmedabad Railway station

Cost includes:

- Travel tickets by second class sleeper train.
- Triple / Four sharing spacious tent, foam mattresses.
- Vegetarian food in fixed camp.
- All meals and water.
- Packed Lunch While trekking.
- Adventure Activities with Mountaineering Instructor.
